After the completion of the Diploma programme learners will acquire a total of 60 credits and they can opt to continue their studies with an Extended Diploma which leads to a one-year top-up degree from some UK Universities. Alternatively, learners can apply directly for the Extended Diploma which has a total of 125 credits and attend classes four times a week.

These Diplomas are eligible for funding under the Get Qualified Scheme issued by Malta Enterprise. Participants can get up to a 70% refund from their total fees.

The fifth intake of the ATHE Level 5 Diploma in Management will start in October 2016 and registrations are already open.
